- ❖ Completion Counts brought awareness 2010 - spring 2013. Resulted in RCC Contract
- ❖ EdTrust West Study 2012
- ❖ Completion Counts gave initial funding fall 2013
- ❖ African American students needed supports within school system. It's all about relationships
- ❖ Funding is now in district LCAP plan



Program Goals

Process

Counselors

- Conduct a summer transcript review and identify students as:
 - 1) On track,
 - 2) Could be on track,
 - 3) Graduation Track,
 - 4) Credit Deficient, needs other supports
- Talk with students who would benefit from schedule changes

Facilitator

- Districtwide Parent information meetings each semester
- Superintendent Advisory
- Guides all program elements

Site Contacts


- meet with Heritage Students
