AICCU is comprised of 85 independent, nonprofit colleges and universities, which make up the Independent California Colleges and Universities (ICCU) sector. The ICCU sector enrolls nearly 200,000 undergraduates or 22% attending a four-year institution in California, and over 180,000 or 58% of graduate students attending a four-year institution in California.
