RE: Final Spring 2023 and Annual 2022-2023 Student Headcount

This memo serves to provides a joint summary of the Spring 2023 and 2022-2023 headcount data for the California Community Colleges system. Continuing the initial improvements in headcount in Fall 2023 ( $+2 \%$ systemwide), systemwide enrollment continued to recover in Spring 2023, leading to our first annual improvement in headcount since 2017-2018.

Spring 2023 headcount increased by 8\% from Spring 2022, from 1,173,645 to 1,273,100 (see Table 1). Nearly all student populations exhibited increases in Spring 2023, including most notably African Americans (+10\%), Hispanics (+11\%), and Native Americans (+13\%). Headcount also increased across age groups, particularly for students 19 years old and younger ( $+14 \%$ ) aided by increases in dual enrollment ( $+16 \%$ ), as well as for students 35 years old or older (between $12 \%$ and $16 \%$ ). While there have been increases for nearly all student groups, including students with disabilities (+12\%), headcount for Filipino students continued to decline (-4\%).

As a result of consecutive semesters of headcount growth, system headcount increased by $5 \%$ from 1,833,539 in 2021-22 to 1,924,060 in 2022-23 (see Table 2), with 94 colleges exhibiting headcount growth year over year across the system. Key historically marginalized student populations exhibiting meaningful increases included African Americans (+7\%), Hispanics ( $+8 \%$ ), and Native Americans ( $+9 \%$ ). Enrollment increased for students 19 years old and younger ( $+11 \%$ ) and for students older than 35 (between $7 \%$ and 12\%). While headcount stabilized or increased for the substantial majority of groups, annual headcount did continue to decline for Filipino students (-6\%), an exception to the overall trend that will require additional systemwide attention to better understand.

While systemwide headcounts have been increasing in recent terms, annual enrollment does down by $\sim 15 \%$ from prior to the pandemic in 2018-2019. However, initial anecdotal reporting from colleges suggests continued improvement in Fall 2023 and beyond, especially as key Vision 2030 strategies are implemented, providing the system a meaningful positive enrollment outlook for the first time in over 5 years.
